# **19<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT BASEBALL SEEDING GUIDELINES**

- 1. Each team will play each district team twice.**

**Games not completed by the second Sunday prior to the date district play begins will be counted as one half game won and one half game lost for seeding purposes.**

- 2. Win – loss record in the district determines whether a team has the number one seed, two seed, three seed and or the fourth seed.**
- 3. The number one seed and the number four seed will play in the first game of the tournament. The number two seed will play the number three seed in the second game of the tournament.**
- 4. Team with the lowest number will always be the home team. Home team will use the third base dugout except when the host team plays.**

## **TWO WAY TIEBREAKERS**

- 1. Winner of second game**
- 2. Fewest runs allowed between the two teams.**

## **THREE WAY TIEBREAKER**

- 1. Team with the best overall record (highest winning % for all games will be the higher seed.**
- 2. If one breaks the 3 way tie, then winner of the second regular season game will be the higher seed between the two remaining teams.**

## **FOUR WAY TIEBREAKER**

- 1. A blind draw will be held for all four positions.**
