

SEEDING PLAN FOR 32nd DISTRICT

BASEBALL

- I. Seeding will be determined by head-to-head competition with district opponents. Each district school shall schedule two games (home and away) against every other district school. The first scheduled meeting of the season between each team will be used to determine seeding for the District Tournament (unless otherwise agreed to by teams involved during scheduling).
- II. In the event that the first game is cancelled, the second game will become the District seed game. If the second game is cancelled, seeding will refer back to the first game played (only in the case of the second game being agreed upon as the seed game during scheduling).
- III. All district games must to be completed prior to one week before the KHSAA District meeting date. The district meeting will be held at the host school's discretion by the KHSAA recommended completion date.
- IV. In the event a district school refuses to schedule other district schools, it will be considered a loss for the refusing team.
- V. In the event of a two-team tie. The tie will be broken by the head to head result of the games between the two schools tied. In case of a split, see article VI.
- VI. In the event more than two teams tie, or two teams split as discussed in article V, the seeding spots will be determined by a blind draw. First draw will be done alphabetically for order of draw. Second draw will determine seeding spot.
- VII. Any game not played will be considered a loss for both teams.
