35th District Seeding Formula

1. Each school will designate what game will be counted as the district game. Some teams in the district will be playing each other twice, so the agreed upon game will count in district standings. If for whatever reason a game can not be played, both teams will receive a "win and a loss" as proposed by the KHSAA.
2. The seeding will be determined by best overall won-loss record in specific district contests.
3. If there is a 2-way tie for a specific position, we will go with the head-to-head tiebreaker.
4. If there is a 3-way tie, we will use a blind draw to determine the specific seedings.
