**BASEBALL 41<sup>ST</sup> DISTRICT  
SEEDING POLICY  
BEGINNING 2006**

*Frankfort, Franklin County, Western Hills, Woodford County*

This proposal will be effective starting in the 2001-2002 baseball season. This proposal may be changed or revised during yearly district tournament meetings for the following season.

All 41<sup>st</sup> district teams will compete in two regular season games against all other 41<sup>st</sup> district teams. Those six games will constitute the district seeding. If, by chance, two district teams compete against each other in regular season tournament play, those games will not count towards district seeding, excluding the Capital City Classic.

If a two way tie results after the six regular season district contest, it will first be broken by examining the head-to-head records of both teams. If a tie still exists, it will be broken by a coin toss.

For a three way tie, numbered cards will be drawn for the top three seeds or the bottom three seeds.

After seeds are determined, the first seed will play the fourth seed and the second seed will play the third seed where the first and second seeds are home teams.

If a season district game is suspended in the middle of play, the game will resume at the suspended point at the next available agreed upon playing date. All suspended games must be completed before the district meeting (usually the Sunday before district tournament week).

If a season district game is cancelled, the make-up game should be played at the first possible open date agreed upon by the involved schools. If a team chooses to forfeit a district game, the game will be counted towards district seeding. All district games must be completed before the district meeting (usually the Sunday before district tournament week).
