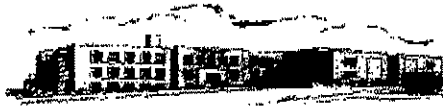

To Whom It May Concern:

We, the Nicholas County School District, would like for you to reconsider our district placement for our football team. We have researched the travel distance and mileage that would be required for us to remain in our current placement and compared it to a district closer to our location. Our current placement, District 7, requires us to travel 315.10 miles, one way, as opposed to being in District 3 and traveling a total of 163.88 miles.

Bracken County, which is in District 3, has a total distance of 227.93 miles. If we were to be placed in District 3, the travel would be 163.88 miles. Not only would this benefit our school district but it would also benefit the other schools in District 3.

As evidence shows, Bracken County is closer to District 7 opponents than Nicholas County. Not only is the distance shorter, but the travel is less hazardous with them being able to use the AA Highway.

Please consider our proposition of trading Nicholas County to District 3 and Bracken County to District 7. As you can easily see, many schools will benefit from the changing of this alignment.
