In support of Bell County's request, we also feel that there is no way that a "region" can stretch from the Louisville-Metro area, all the way to Bell County HS. We all anticipated that with the new realignment under the 6 class system, that travel for some would be lengthy within our own district, but potential regional playoffs that call for 3-4 hr trips just isn't right. Neither teams nor the communities which support them should be asked to make such a trip, especially when there are numerous other schools, within the same classification, that are much closer.

Suggestion 1

District 4 becomes: Casey County, Garrard County, Wayne County, McCreary Central, Corbin. Even though the travel with this set-up is still lengthy, it still eliminates the extra 45-1 hr drive to Bell County. Bell County would be moved to District 7, as the travel for them would be much closer for district and region play. Garrard County would move out of district 5, thus still allowing District 4 to be a 5 team district.

Suggestion 2

Could Districts 4 and 5 switch? This would cause for closer travel within all schools in region 2, with the exception of Casey County whom is currently in District 4. Casey County is the only school that would be closer for all teams traveling from District 3. All other schools in District 5 are within a closer proximity, both in time and mileage to schools in District 3, than the schools in District 4.

District 5 becomes District 4

District 4 becomes District 5

District 7 becomes District 6

District 6 becomes District 7

District 8 remains the same

Suggestion 3

If neither of these are suitable, then we request that District 4 stays the same with the exception of Bell County, who could easily move into District 7. This would now cause District 4 to be a four-team district, but they wouldn't be alone, because there are others. If having four-team districts is ok for other classes (See: 4A Dist. 6, 2A Dist. 8 and 5A Dist. 8), then it shouldn't be a problem here either.

Hodgenville- Irvine (Estill County)=130 miles

Hodgenville-Stanton (Powell County)= 125 miles (<2.5 hrs estimated drive)

Hodgenville- Paris (Bourbon Co)= 101 miles

Hodgenville- Lancaster (Garrard Co)= 74 miles
