Section III. To be completed by schools desiring to see other alignment changes.

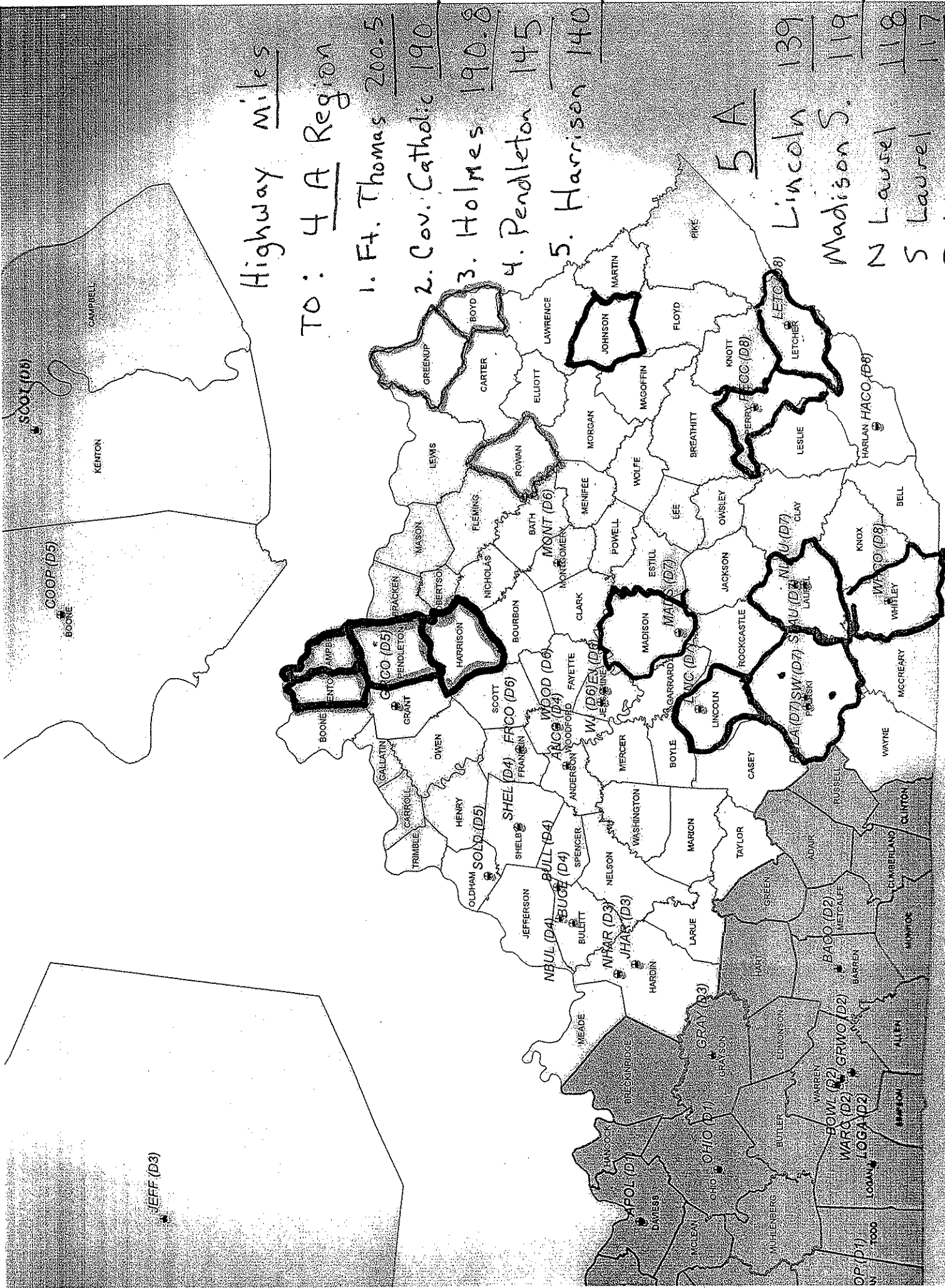

Dear Commissioner Tackett:

I fully support and advocate for Johnson Central High School's request to be placed in Class 5A District 8 instead of 4A District 8 as proposed in the KHSAA Football Alignment for the 2011 through 2014 seasons.

Although it may be argued that the 4A District 8 classification may not be a burden for district games, regional games would take place approximately 200 miles from Paintsville in Northern Kentucky.

Johnson Central High School, like all other schools across the Commonwealth, is making difficult budget decisions. In such tough economic times, the expense of transporting the football team 200 miles to Northern Kentucky and 200 miles back is not feasible.

This also an issue of the safety of the children of Johnson County. Johnson Central High School will be forced to transport children on the Mountain Parkway, a two lane highway, late at night in potentially dangerous mountain weather conditions. It is unacceptable to put the children and families of Johnson County in this hazardous position unnecessarily.

Further, two other schools which should have been classified as 4A based upon enrollment numbers, Letcher County Central and Cooper, have already been reassigned based upon geographical concerns. Both schools have lower enrollment levels than Johnson Central and were allowed to "play up" due to geographical concerns. To be consistent with these modifications, KHSAA should also grant Johnson Central's appeal.


My final objection to the placement of Johnson Central High School in 4A District 8, is that classification is purportedly based upon the average number of males for 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 school years. This year these numbers did not include students enrolled in alternative schools in Johnson County. In previous years, these students have always been included in enrollment numbers. Based upon Edmonson County's denied appeal of the inclusion of the Alternative School numbers for that County's class assignment, the inclusion or exclusion of alternative school numbers is not a policy which KHSAA is applying consistently to all schools. KHSAA is charged with establishing policies and applying those policies consistently to all schools. If Edmonson County is required to include the alternative school numbers, Johnson Central must include the alternative school numbers as well. The inclusion of the alternative school numbers places Johnson Central in 5A.

For the above reasons, I submit that KHSAA is required to grant Johnson Central High Schools request to play in 5A District 8 in order to be consistent in applying the rules which are established as the basis for alignment. Any other ruling would be contrary to those established rules and arbitrary in application.

I am unable to attend the hearing on October 18, 2010 due to scheduling conflicts. However, I am sending my Chief of Staff, Becky Barnes, who will be able to articulate my concerns and speak on my behalf.
