To Whom It May Concern:

We would like the KHSAA to consider moving Anderson County High School from 5A District 4 to 5A District 6. Our request relates to geographic concerns and travel mileage. Here is the comparison mileage wise for our school between the two districts according to "mapquest":

5A District 4

Shelby County- 25

Bullitt East- 54

Bullitt Central- 64

North Bullitt- 57

Avg. distance for a district game= 50 miles

5A District 6

Woodford County- 12

Franklin County- 17

East Jessamine- 27

West Jessamine- 29

Montgomery County- 69

Avg. distance for a district game= 30 miles

In comparing the two districts, the average distance for a district game is 20 miles less in District 6. Also, in District 6 we would have 4 schools within 29 miles or less as compared to 1 in District 6.
