

KHSAA RULES AND REGULATIONS

Governing Cross Country Meets

[As Adopted by the Board of Control]

[Case situations refer to rulings and interpretations used to interpret and administer these provisions which can be found in the Case Situation section of the Handbook. [When possible, additional cross-referencing information has been included].

I) Assignment of Schools to Regions

A) CLASSES

The Kentucky High School Athletic Association shall sponsor post-season competition in cross country and track for boys and girls, provided that fifteen (15) percent of the member schools declare intentions to participate in said competition. Member schools desiring to participate in KHSAA sponsored postseason competition shall notify the Association office prior to September 1. The state shall be initially divided into three classes based on a multiple-year average enrollment, with each class containing six (6) regions. The Commissioner shall divide the state into geographic sections with the approval of the Board of Control.

As of August 1, 2006, the alignment for boys' and girls' cross country and track is as follows —
