

KHSAA RULES AND REGULATIONS

Governing the Football Championships

(Adopted by the Board of Control)

(Case situations refer to rulings and interpretations used to administer these provisions which can be found in the next section of the Handbook)

I) Assignment of Schools to Districts, Regions and Classes

A) CLASSES

The Kentucky High School Athletic Association shall sponsor postseason competition in football for boys, provided that fifteen (15) percent of the member schools declare intentions to participate in said competition. Member schools desiring to participate in KHSAA sponsored postseason competition shall notify the Association office prior to September 1. Classification shall be based on enrollment in grades 9-12 including all special education students. The state shall be divided into four classes based on enrollment by the Commissioner, with the approval of the Board of Control. Newly added or deleted programs will be handled on a case by case basis by the Commissioner's office
