



**DISTRICT SCHEDULING GRID, 2011 through 2014 SEASONS
(Home to be determined by mutual agreement, lettering can be agreed or drawn)**

The scheduling priority for district games shall be week 9, followed by 8, followed by 7, followed by 6, followed by 5. Use 4 only if necessary for schedule conflict..

NOTES

1. Written permission from the Commissioner's office must be obtained to deviate from the scheduling grid by playing earlier than the listed weeks.
2. Week 10 may never be a district game. Permission will NOT be granted to play a non-district game this week. The Commissioner's office reserves the right to void an earlier signed contact in order to play a necessary game in the event that a contract signed prior to the moratorium date forces a school to need to play a district game in week 10.
3. Week 0 (NFHS week 7) may only be used in the case of a school giving up one of its two scrimmages and having an off week during the year.
4. Other weeks (Specifically 4, 5 and 6 in a 4-team district, week 4 in a five- or six-team district) should only be used for district games if it is necessary to move the game from one of the priority dates due to fall breaks or another existing condition that necessitates the use of those weeks. This may only be done with written permission from the Commissioner.
5. If a district should fall to three teams, the teams will each play twice (at each site, home and home) to determine the district champion.
6. The letters A, B, C, D, E and F below represent up to six teams in a district which can be assigned by specific school or drawn by lot to determine the regular season games at the discretion of a majority vote of those effected schools.
