REQUIREMENTS FOR OFFICIALS FOR POST SEASON PLAY

2008 ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSIGNMENTS

In order to be assigned, an official shall -

- Have been licensed by June 30 in order to work rounds 2 through 5,
- Be currently licensed in order to work round 1,
- Be eligible and in good standing with local association rules if more stringent than KHSAA rules and if such rules were in place at the time of the first meeting.,
- Attend a minimum of four local association meetings for the entire membership of the organization (KHSAA Rules Clinic and Part II exams do *not* count),
- Take and pass Part II Exam with a score of 80 in order to work rounds 2 through 5,
- Take and pass Part II Exam with a score of 75 in order to work round 1,
- Be a Level 2 or 3 official in order to work rounds 2 through 5,
- Be a Level 1 official in order to work round 1,
- Have worked in round one and/or two in order to work rounds 3, 4 and/or 5, and
- Have worked a majority of their regular season varsity schedule (at least seven games) at the position being nominated (linesman and line judge work are interchangeable) for rounds 3, 4 and 5 (collegiate work at the position may also substitute).

I do hereby certify that any recommendations made for postseason assignments shall only include eligible officials in accordance with these standards, including but not limited to, the requirement for attendance at a minimum number of local association meetings.

A copy of this form shall be forwarded to the Chairperson of each Regional Policy Board by the KHSAA for use in the evaluation process.
