

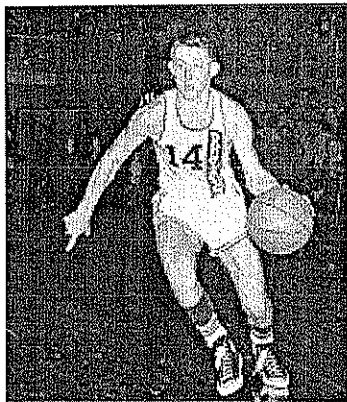

Ronnie Lyons was a scoring machine for the Royals



Ronnie Lyons was a 5' 10" sharpshooting, high scoring guard for the Mason County Royals from 1967 to 1970. What Lyons lacked in size he made up with quickness and uncanny shooting skills. Lyons poured in the points from long range (much longer than the current three-point arc) when there was no three-point shot. Crowds packed The Fieldhouse to watch Lyons and the Royals play. Lyons played at the University of Kentucky and was on Adolph Rupp's final team as a sophomore. Lyons was also a baseball star at Mason County. He was selected by the New York Mets in the 38th round of the 1970 First-Year Player Draft. Here are some of his basketball career highlights at Mason County and UK:

Mason County

- Scored 2,621 career points (second on the Royals' alltime scoring list)
- Holds the school-record for points scored as a senior (1,216);
- Holds the single-season school record for scoring average (33.8 ppg);
- Scored a school-record 60 points vs. Bourbon County in 1970;
- Scored 40 or more points in a game 11 times;
- Scored 30 or more points in a game 32 times;
- In one eight-game stretch of his senior season, Lyons had games of 45, 45, 26, 44, 47, 38, 45 and 60 points;
- Scored 25 points in the *second quarter* of the 1970 district championship game vs. Maysville and ended up with 48 points;
- Named to the Herald-Leader and Courier-Journal All-State Teams;
- Named a Prep All-American by Coach and Athlete Magazine;
- Played for the 1970 Kentucky All-Stars in the annual series vs. Indiana;
- Played in the Dapper Dan Classic in Pennsylvania
- Was the first Mason County player to have his jersey retired;

- Scored 786 career points;
- Scored a career-high 28 points vs. Mississippi State his junior season;
- Played all 50 minutes and scored 19 points in a 90-89 double overtime loss to Indiana his sophomore season;
- Won the Freshman Leadership Award in 1971;
- Led the Wildcats in free throw shooting in the 1971-72 season (87.5% on 70-of-80);
- Was the team's third-leading scorer in the 1971-72 season (13.2 ppg)
- Had the fewest turnovers in both the 1972-73 and 1973-74 seasons;
- Won the 110 Percent Award in 1973;
- Named Outstanding Senior in 1974;

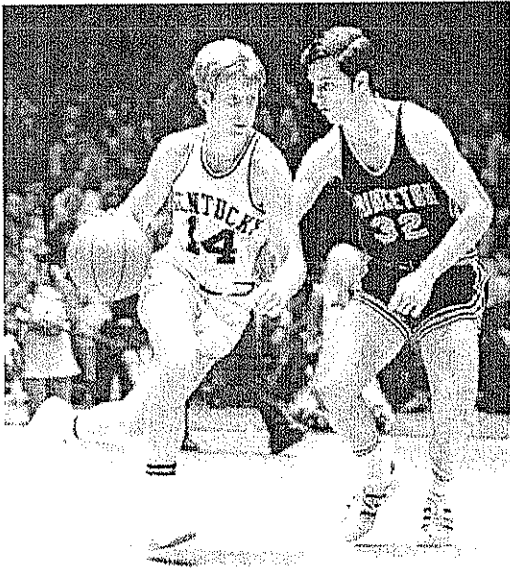

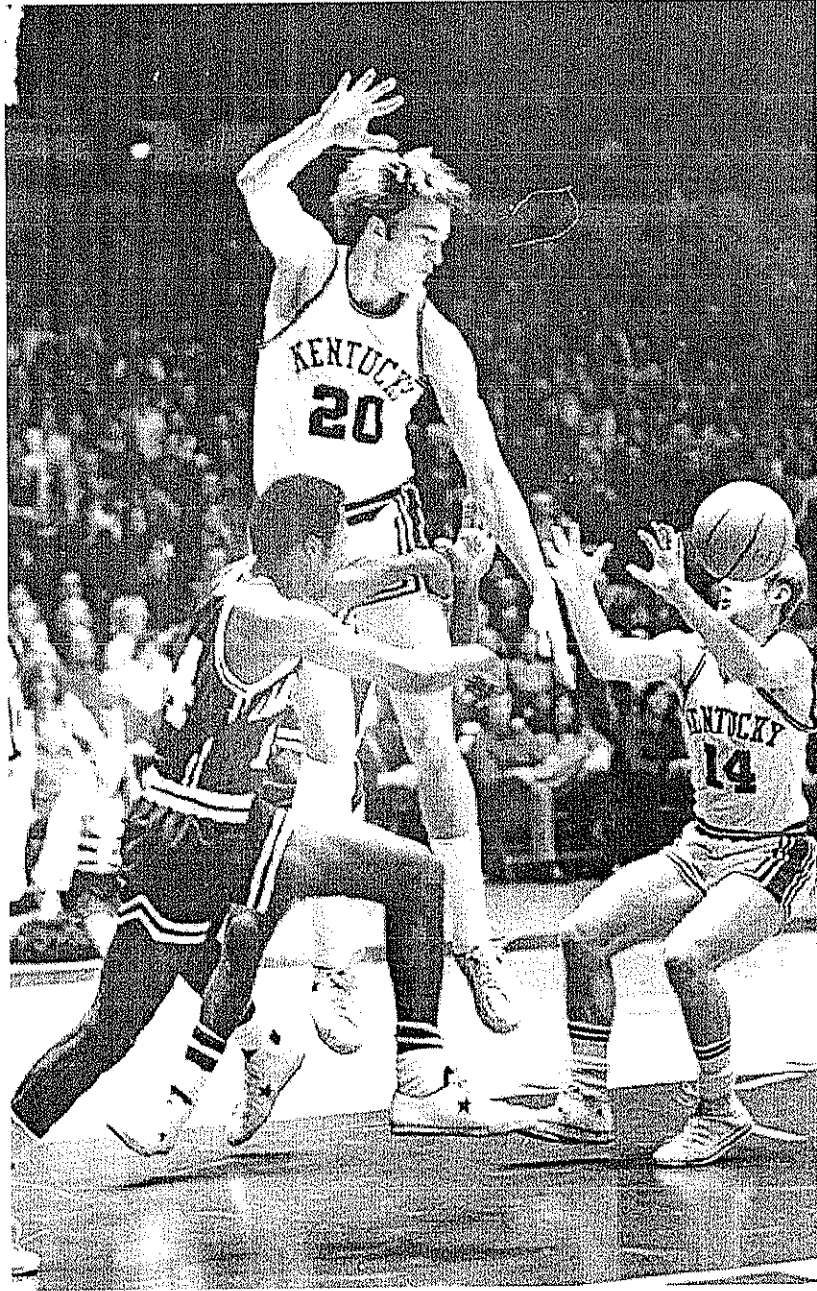

Ronnie Lyons and his exploits

Memories are like money in the bank, they are worth more over time. How time flies, as on Dec 1, 1971, Ronnie Lyons made his varsity debut at UK. The NCAA rules back then were that freshman was ineligible for varsity play. Ronnie was starting his sophomore year at UK. This would be Coach Rupp's final year coaching at UK. Ronnie was in the starting lineup as the Cats faced Northwestern in Memorial Coliseum. Lyons tallied 11 points in 26 minutes and handed out 3 assists. Ronnie Lyons attended Kentucky after a stellar career at Mason County. The Fieldhouse would be packed with fans from all over to watch Lyons do his thing. His thing was nailing shots from behind where the three point line is now and his quick hands creating havoc on defense. Ronnie was a five foot ten inch dynamo that made up his lack of size with shooting and passing skills. Ronnie scored 2,621 points in his playing days with the Royals and holds the record with most points scored by a senior with 1,216 points. Ronnie Lyons still holds the single-season school record for scoring average (33.8 ppg a game. He tallied 40 points or more eleven times during his days as a Royal. Thirty two times, Ronnie scored over 30 points with a 60 point outburst against Bourbon County. In a mind boggling eight-game stretch of his senior season, Lyons had games of 45, 45, 26, 44, 47, 38, 45 and 60 points. For me being a Bulldog fan, he broke my heart as he poured in 25 points against the Bulldogs in the second quarter alone as he ended up with 48 points. Ronnie in my opinion got robbed of the Mr. Basketball award as it went to Richard Brooks of Richmond Madison. Ronnie never got to show his skills in the state tourney as his Royals never made it to the big show. Ronnie played in the Kentucky- Indiana All Star game and also played in the prestigious Dapper Dan Classic in Pennsylvania. Ronnie scored 786 points at UK and he scored a career-high 28 points vs. Mississippi State his junior season. Time does fly but we do have our memories of Ronnie Lyons at Mason County and the University of Kentucky.

Ronnie Lyons led the UK Wildcats to a Mideast regional win on this date, March 16th of 1972. It turned out to be the Baron of Kentucky, Adolph Rupp's last victory. It was a semifinal match-up between the UK Wildcats and the highly ranked Marquette Warriors who was coached by the legendary Al McGuire. The Marquette squad was ranked number seven in the final polls and the Wildcats came into the game with a national ranking of the eighteenth best team in the land. The game was played in Dayton, Ohio at the University of Dayton Arena. The Cats had beaten their SEC rivals, the Tennessee Vols in the previous game by the score of 67 to 66. Ronnie Lyons of Mason County was a vital cog in this victory as the Cats upset the Warriors in this NCAA tourney game. Ronnie pumped in a team high 19 points and dished out five assists and his constant quick hands contributed too many steals for Rupp's Cats. Adolph surprised Al McGuire with a 1-3-1 zone defense to go along with his trademark man to man defense. It was to be Rupp's final victory as the man in the brown suit at the helm of the University of Kentucky Wildcats. The Cats went down to defeat to the Florida State Noles in the Mideast regional finals in the next game. This was the final game of Adolph Rupp as he got beat by the score of 73 to 54. It is hard to believe it has been 39 years since Rupp roamed the sideline, but the former Mason County Royals standout, Ronnie Lyons was the man in Rupp's last win.

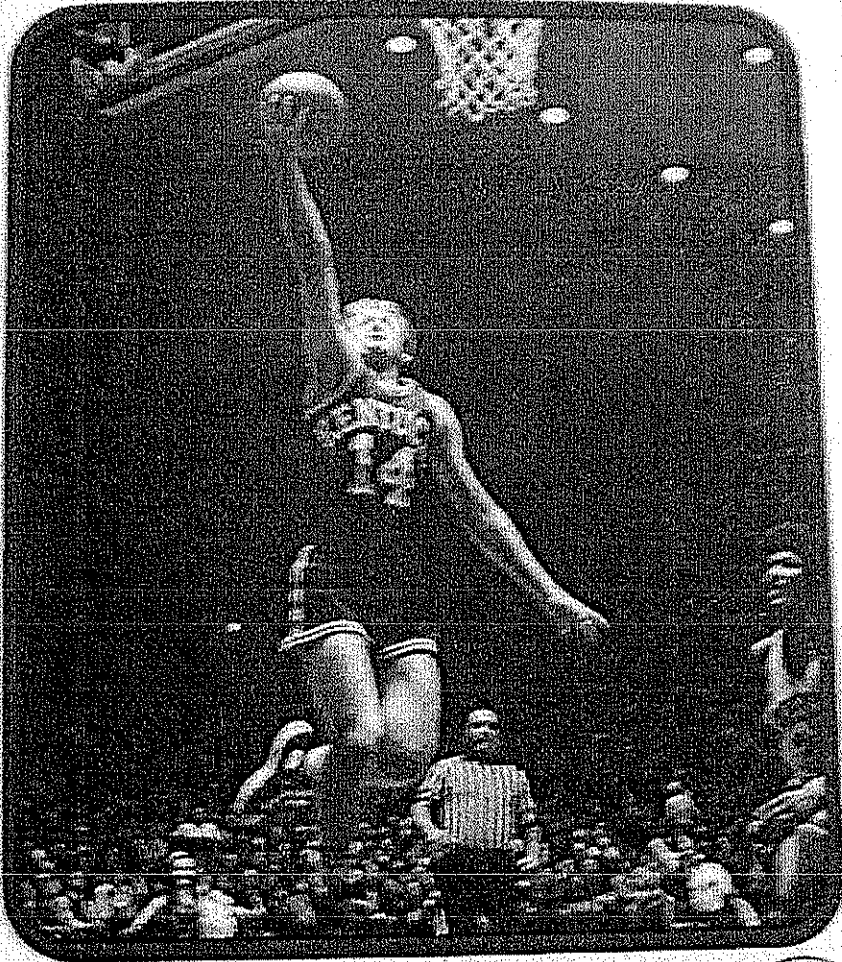
