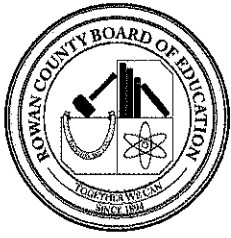

Dear Nominations Committee:

As a former cheer coach, a member of the NFHS Spirit Rules Committee, a KAPOs Past President, and a supporter of the KHSAA and Hall of Fame, it is a pleasure for me to write this recommendation for one of our leaders in Kentucky cheerleading—**Ann Parker Upchurch**.

I first met Ann in 1980 when she was the KAPOs President and I was a young, inexperienced (meaning I knew NOTHING) cheer coach. Although she was very busy with a multitude of other things, she was willing to assist me and answer the dozens of (silly to her, I'm sure) questions that I continually had. Region 12 has been well represented by Ann who graduated from Boyle County and then went on to coach at both Lincoln County and Wayne County. In a region that is packed with excellent cheerleading, her teams won several district titles as well as three (3) regional championships. More than titles though, Ann has always served as a role model for what young ladies and gentlemen should strive to become.

Ann worked as a teacher, counselor, and administrator in a number of schools across the Commonwealth, as well as in the Hawaii Public Schools. Kentucky schools include Anderson County, Wayne County, Lincoln County, Russell Independent, and Morehead State University. I know that Ann has touched the lives of many, many young people in her career.
