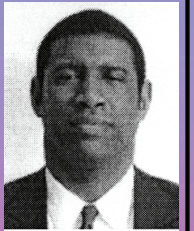
Directions from I-64 West

Bob Gansler



➤ The National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) featured clinician for this year's KHSSCA Convention is American coaching legend Bob Gansler. He currently serves as a member of the NSCAA National Academy staff.

➤ Gansler has enjoyed coaching success at the highest levels of the game in the United

States. As former head coach of the United States Men's National Team, he led the Americans to the 1990 World Cup, its first appearance in the tournament in 40 years. He served as head coach of the Kansas City Wizards of Major League Soccer from 1999-2006 leading the team to the MLS Cup Championship in 2000 and the United States Open Cup title in 2004. He was named MLS Coach of the Year in 2000. Most recently he served as assistant coach and technical director for Toronto FC (2006-07).

➤ Gansler's previous coaching stints included experience at virtually every level of the game in the United States. He led the men's U-19 and U-20 National Teams before taking the reins of the full national team in 1989. Previously, he served as the Marquette University High School coach from 1973-76 and coached at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee from 1984-88. His professional coaching resume prior to MLS included the Milwaukee Rampage (1996-98), which he led to the A-League title in 1997.

➤ As a player, Gansler was a member of the U.S. National Team where he served as captain of the 1964 and 1968 United States Olympic teams. He has received numerous soccer honors in this country including the prestigious Walt Chyzowych Award in 2000 and was inducted into the United Soccer Leagues Hall of Fame in 2002.
