

## **KHSAA TRACK & FIELD AND CROSS COUNTRY ALIGNMENT**

### **PROPOSED REVISIONS**

ALIGNMENT TO BEGIN WITH 2008-2009 COMPETITION SEASON (TRACK AND CROSS COUNTRY)

CLASS 1A – 0 – 600 average, last two years, four grade enrollment, 118 schools (114 in present alignment), 8 regions, geography primary determinant

CLASS 2A – 601 – 1024.9 average last two years, four grade enrollment, 96 schools (85 in present alignment), 8 regions, geography primary determinant (consolidation of 7 and 8 made difficult by track entries and meet format)

CLASS 3A – 1025 and up average last two years, four grade enrollment, 65 schools (79 in present alignment), 7 regions, geography primary determinant

Post Season –

TRACK

- 6, 7 or 8 regions – Top finisher in each event, plus 10 (6 regions) 9 (7 regions), or 8 (8 region) best times / marks overall statewide to create 16 entries in each event. In addition, entries meeting qualifying standard would be entered.

CROSS COUNTRY

- From each region- continue to advance top 5, 6 or 7 finishers not on placing teams
- Base region advancement on number of teams with full complement entering, with goal being to have 24 total teams advance as per current.
- Minimum 2 teams per region.
- Attempt to keep state field at same size or higher by no more than 10%
