## **TEAM LODGING ASSIGNMENTS**

In order to receive KHSAA lodging expense reimbursement, teams must stay at their assigned hotel. All teams meeting lodging provisions must stay at the designated assigned hotel or forfeit their hotel reimbursement.

Schools (Principal, Athletic Director or Head Coach) must call NO LATER THAN NOON, MONDAY, 26 to secure their team's room allotment. Ten (10) rooms have been set aside at the property for your team's use with two double beds (four per room). Fans wishing to stay at the listed property or nearby properties will need to secure their own lodging.

When calling for lodging arrangements, please provide them with a rooming list for each room. You may inquire about faxing the list instead. When making payment for rooms, a school credit card or school check must be used to receive tax exempt status – no exceptions (please have your Tax ID# available).

Teams are reimbursed:

- 1) \$208 per night for lodging – nights reimbursed will be determined based on distance travelled and length of participation in the tournament.
- 2) \$1 for each round trip mile to and from the tournament based on AAA.
- 3) \$80 per meal – based on length of participation in the tournament.

## **TEAM EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT**

Local Team (less than 40 one way miles from tournament site)

Mileage: \$25 per day of play

Meals: \$90 per day of play

Lodging: No lodging allowance

Non-Local Team (more than 40 one way miles from tournament site)

Mileage: \$1 per round trip mile for actual mileage (furnished by AAA)

Meals: \$5 per meal based for 16 individuals (15 players/1 coach)

Lodging: Maximum of \$13 per night per each of 16 participants

## **PARTICIPANTS/BENCH**

The team roster as entered on the KHSAA website prior to the beginning of the postseason shall serve as the eligibility roster for the event. Teams may dress a maximum of 15 players per contest in uniform and seated at the bench. The total number of bench personnel (including head coach, assistant coaches, managers, trainer, non dressing members) shall not exceed the maximum of 20. (individuals may rotate through the event as long as they appear on the roster).

A maximum of 15 players shall be dressed

## **STATE PARTICIPATION FORM/TEAM PASS LIST (KHSAA FORM VB113)**

Complete the Volleyball Participating Team Pass list (Form VB113) and fax to the KHSAA (859)293-5999 no later than noon (Eastern Time) Tuesday, Oct. 27. This list should include team members, coaches, administrators, trainers and any other individual (Superintendent, Principal, Athletic Director) involved with your travelling party. The list should not exceed 25 members.

Past list members will be admitted at the Pass Gate (located at the front lobby of Regents Hall).

## **MEDICAL VERIFICATION**

Coaches should have verification for permission for medical treatment for their athletes available in case of injury. This permission is included on the KHSAA Physical Examination Form (Form GE4) which is signed by every athlete prior to practice or play.

## **TRAINING STAFF**

The staff of Northern Kentucky University will provide training assistance. They will be available beginning 1 hour prior to each contest.

## **COACH/OFFICIALS PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING**

There will be a mandatory coach/official meeting at 8:30 a.m. (ET) on Friday, Oct. 30 at the facility. All head coaches and officials must attend.

## **ADMISSION/TICKETS**

Gates will open for teams and fans 1 hour prior to the first contest of each session. General admission tickets will be priced at \$7 per session with an all-session pass will be available for \$18. Children under six will be admitted free of charge.

Gate times include team’s earliest permitted arrival.

## **PARKING**

Team Parking (Bus/Van) will be in Lot G next to the softball field and within walking distance of Regents Hall. Spectator parking will be available in Lot S and the Kenton Drive Garage. Parking for spectators will be \$2 each per day.

## **LOCKER ROOM ASSIGNMENTS**

Lock room space is available and assignments will be made when teams arrive. Teams should come dressed and ready to play. The KHSAA is not responsible for loss of valuables.

## **WARM-UP TIME/BALLS**

There will be a warm-up court provided. Teams may bring their own balls for use on the warm-up court. The KHSAA will provide practice (12 per team) and game balls on the main Regents Hall court. Warm-up time on the main Regents Hall court will use the 4-4-4-2-1 format (4 minutes to stretch, 4 minutes for each team with the serving team taking the court first, 2 minutes for serving and 1 minute back at the bench area).

Friday, Oct. 30

Championship Court – timed warm-ups begin at 10:10 until 10:25 a.m., followed by introductions (entire team) and the National Anthem. The anthem will be played prior to the first contest of each session.

Saturday, Oct. 31

Championship Court – timed warm-ups begin at 8:40 until 8:55, followed by introductions (starters only, plus libero) and the National Anthem.

State Championship

Doors open at 6:30 p.m. – Court available for warm-up

Timed Warm-ups begin at 7 until 7:15 p.m., followed by KVCA Player/Coach of the Year Awards, March-In, Introductions and the National Anthem.

## **TOURNAMENT CEREMONIES/PINK OUT**

For the first contest for each team (Friday's matches), seniors will be provided a commemorative mini ball to throw into the stands during team introductions. All team members will be introduced on the end line prior to their first contest only.

Saturday night will be designated as Pink Out – Pass...Pink...Cure! ...for breast cancer awareness. Throughout the tournament, contest officials will wear pink and use pink whistles. For the championship, each squad will be provided a pink t-shirt to wear during introductions. We invite schools to wear pink throughout the week to help support the awareness cause. For the final, full team introductions will again be conducted on the endlines.

## **TELEVISION**

With the assistance of Northern Kentucky University, the KHSAA will air the semifinals and finals on a delayed basis. The championship will be streamed live by [ihigh.com](http://ihigh.com). Insight Northern Kentucky and Louisville will also air the semi-finals and finals on a taped delayed basis.

## **VIDEOTAPING**

Spectators may videotape with a hand-held camera from the spectator area. No tripod/monopod is permitted or use of house electricity.

One "Team Video" camera will be permitted in a designated area to tape only the contest of the team. No "scout" videotaping is permitted.

### **SIGNAGE/BALLOONS/NOISEMAKERS**

Signs/banners are permitted inside Regents Hall, but must be of good taste and sportsmanship. The covering of any corporate signage is not permitted. Signs must be hand-held or taped using masking tape. Balloons are not permitted in the facility.

Noisemakers (thunderstix, megaphones, etc.) are not permitted inside the facility per NFHS Rules.

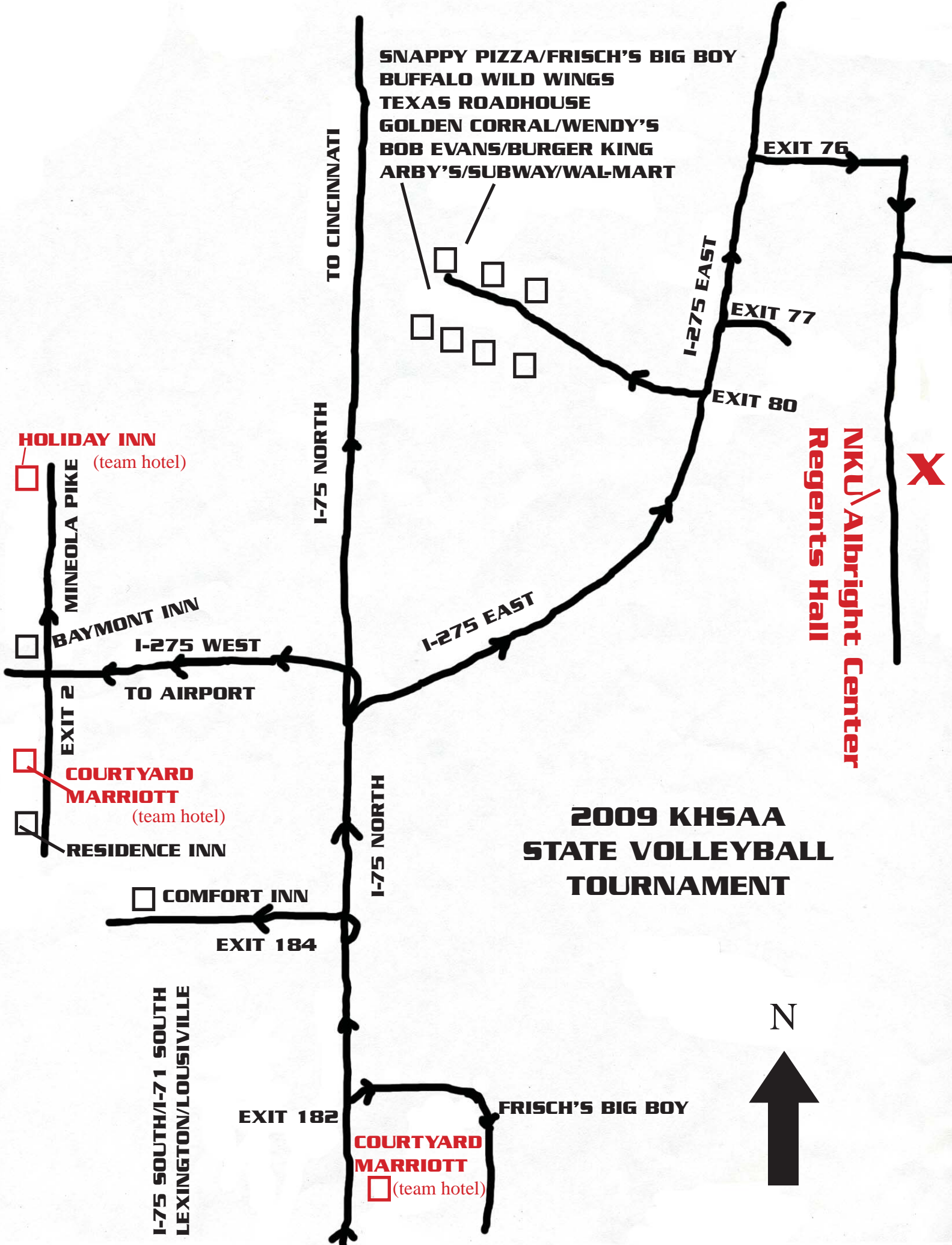
### **RESTRICTED AREAS**
